## **TERRACYCLE**

Are you spring cleaning? Are you going through your cabinets and clearing out the clutter? Don't forget to TerraCycle those old or expired beauty products that you may be tossing.

The Beauty brigade is the largest and, in my opinion, the easiest brigade to collect. Basically, any product you put on your body or hair is included. The two things we CAN NOT accept are metal cans and glass bottles. So a plastic sunscreen bottle is a yes, but an aerosol can of sunscreen is a no.
